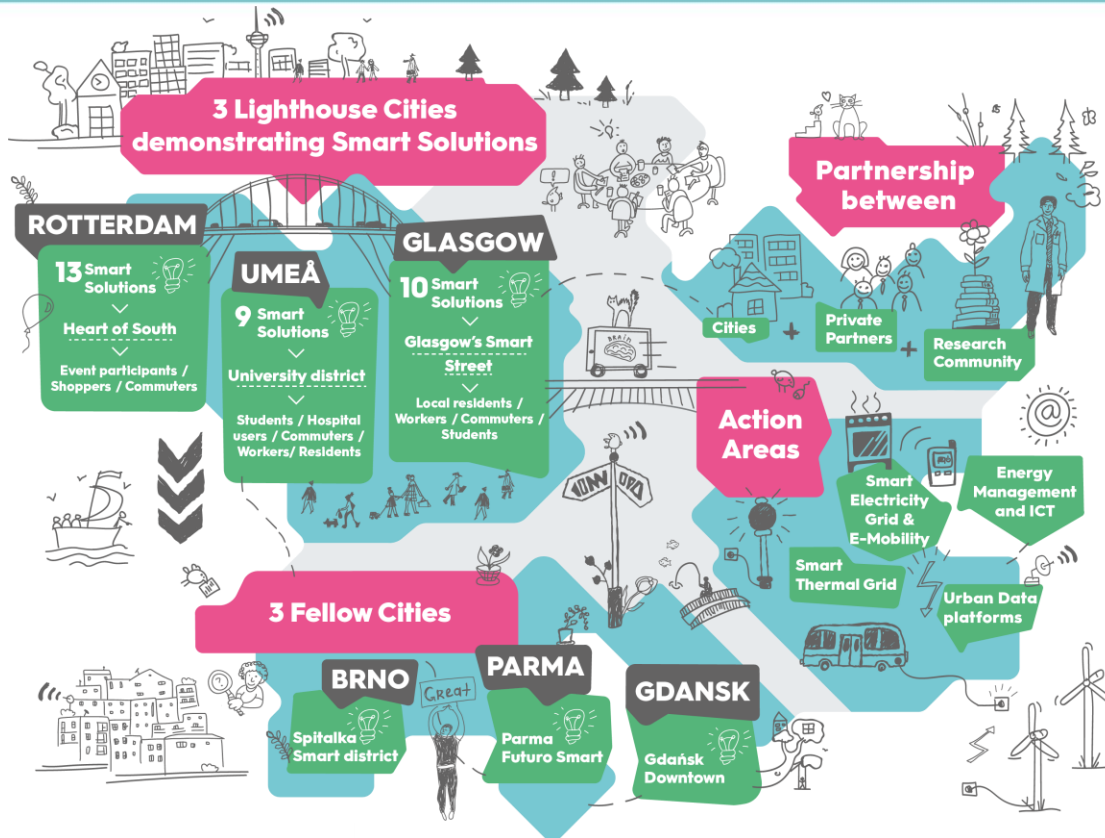

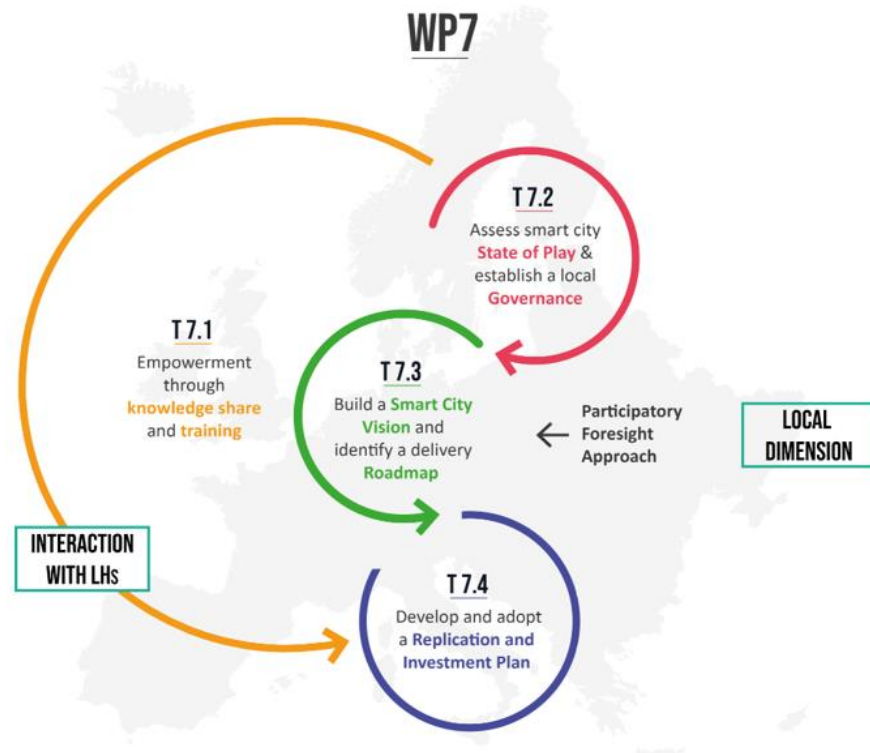


Replication approach in RUGGEDISED
