Sustainable Glasgow

- The Sustainable Glasgow Partnership was formed in 2010
- Bringing together the public and private sector in a collaborative space
- Partnership aimed to achieve a target of reducing the city's CO₂ emission by 30% on a 2006 baseline.
- The partnership delivered a strategy to achieve this goal and, through hard work, innovation, and collaboration, managed to achieve the 30% target in 2015
- As of 2018, CO₂ emissions have been reduced by 37.5%.



Sustainable Glasgow



In 2019, Glasgow declared a Climate and Ecological Emergency, whilst also setting a target of being carbon neutral by 2030.



The council launched its draft of a Climate Emergency Implementation Plan and its Circular Economy Routemap.



City must work in partnership to achieve new targets and tackle climate emergency.



As a result, the council decided to restructure the Sustainable Glasgow partnership.

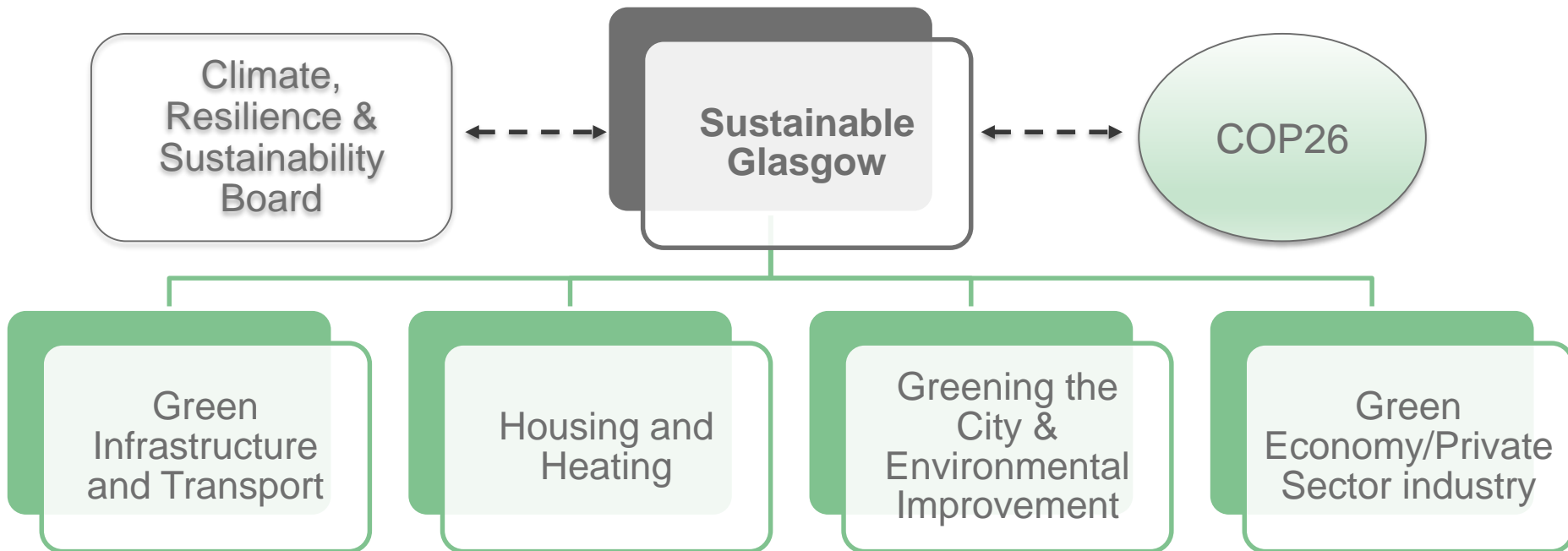
